Coronavirus / Covid-19 Update, Vol. 26 **July 30, 2020**

Dear Friends,

As you probably are aware, the rest of the Country is now struggling with an increase in Covid cases more than Connecticut. At our Statewide conference call yesterday the Connecticut Commissioner of Health reiterated the need for people returning from States on the Connecticut Travel Advisory list to quarantine for two weeks. Remember, 40% of Covid carriers are Asymptomatic and may not know they are infected. Testing is not a substitute for quarantining.

The Commissioner reported that people are returning to Connecticut from hotspots sick and contagious. Another area of concern is large parties. I urge you to keep on with the masks and hand washes.

We have been working closely with the Board of Education to plan and prepare to safely open CCS on September 8, 2020. There is a Town Zoom Meeting with the Board of Education scheduled for **Wednesday August 5, 2020 at 4:15 PM - Town Presentation: School Reopening Plan.** (The Zoom Link and Dial-in numbers for the meeting are below.)
