

Apart Together Coronavirus / Covid-19 Update, Vol. 33 October 29, 2020

Hello Friends,

Unfortunately, Covid case numbers continue to spread in Connecticut and our area. After having one confirmed case in Cornwall since May, two were recorded last week here. Similar slight upticks are happening in other nearby towns with Geer Village in North Canaan reporting over 30 confirmed cases. Contact tracing has limited the spread of these outbreaks. As predicted more indoor Fall activities are pushing the infection numbers upward. Most of the new infections are happening at social events where people do not do the basic mask wearing, social distancing or hand sanitizing. I encourage residents who travel, trick or treat, or vote in the near future to follow the CDC's basic guidelines: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/index.html>.

On the brighter side, community support for social services and food pantry, the Trinity Retreat Center in West Cornwall, and the Ellis Garden on Town Street have stocked the food pantry with fresh vegetables.
