#### **Board of Selectmen**

First Selectman Ridgway reported briefly on the following items:

- a) There was a large turnout for the pre-bid meeting for the Smith Place and Gravel Bank bridges, both bid packages are presented as "design build". There were 24 people representing 8 companies which translates to a very competitive environment. The bids are due back by 6/4 and when the projects are awarded the successful bidder(s) will have 120 days to complete the project(s).
- b) The 5/8 meeting at the WC Library put on by the WC Septic committee was attended by members of CT DEEP, Torrington Area Health officials and many interested citizens of Cornwall. The general takeaway from this meeting is that the ultimate decision is a local decision, there is quite a bit of additional testing that should take place before any decisions are made and the engineers are still exploring locations and will be providing additional information. It was noted that there are many options and the construction sewer lines and installing a processing plant is only one option. Also noted; there is a lot of pushback from some citizens that are not in favor of continuing this study or construction of a waste water processing facility.
- c) HVA has updated the Selectmen regarding the grant they have to put in a parking lot and a boat access on property adjacent to the WC Library. HVA will be bringing a revised proposal to the Town.

In accordance with Section 12-165 of the Connecticut General Statutes, I request that the attached listing of unpaid and uncollectible personal property and motor vehicle taxes on the rate books of the Town of Cornwall be submitted to the Board of Finance for approval for transfer to the Suspense Tax Book. Last year we put delinquent tax bills from Grand List year 2012 on suspense, and bills that had been returned as "undeliverable" or for people who had moved out of state. This year I am requesting that the year 2013 delinquent bills be put on suspense, plus bills that have been returned, for those individuals who have moved out of state, and for deceased individuals.

The accounts presented for transfer to Suspense include \$4,793.46 in Motor Vehicle Taxes and Interest, \$330.40 in Supplemental Motor Vehicle Taxes and Interest, and \$3,321.53 in Personal Property Taxes and Interest on the Grand Lists of 2002 and 2003, and 2013 through 2016. This comes to a total of \$8,445.39 in unpaid taxes and interest. The only unusual accounts going onto Suspense are the two Motor Vehicle bills from James Gardner (deceased), bill #'s 2002/300518 and 2003/300475. These were put on suspense a number of years ago, but got dropped from the list during the transition from the Alden Novak and Dodd tax software to the QDS software.

Please note that even though the recommended accounts will be removed from the active tax rolls, they are still collectible. Once these bills are put on suspense I can forward to them to the collection agency for action. In the past year we have collected \$1,129.33 in taxes and interest by using the collection agency and the threat to use the agency.

Your favorable support for this Suspense List is requested. I am available to answer any questions you may have concerning this agenda item.
