#3 - Reports

Board of Selectmen

First Selectman Ridgway gave brief updates of the following items.

- a) Bridge Projects: The bridge replacements at the gravel bank and Smith Place are on schedule. The Smith Place replacement is complete and the gravel bank bridge should be completed within the next few weeks. The remaining \$300,000 +/- left in the bridge funding borrowing will be utilized for detailed maintenance on approximately 6 bridges.
- b) Building Inventory Project is in progress and the insulation project at the West Cornwall Firehouse is underway. Jim Terrall will be issuing the report by the end of the calendar year, it is hopeful that rough estimates will be available sometime in November.
- d) West Cornwall Wastewater: A funding opportunity for this project is available through the USDA Water & Waste Disposal Loan & Grant Program. The loan term is up to 40 years and based on the useful life of the facilities financed with a fixed interest rate. The committee is continuing to explore all options regarding systems, placement and funding.

- a) The Audit has been completed and is available in pdf format. All members expressed interest in receiving a copy of the Financial Statements and supporting documents via email. There are five transfers that move unexpended funds within the Board of Selectmen's budget to cover departmental lines that exceeded their budgeted appropriations.
