Unfortunately, there has been a resurgence of COVID since the beginning of September in our area with neighboring towns moving from grey to red zones according to state health data. Cornwall has seen a marked rise recently as well. The good news is that vaccinations have helped reduce hospitalizations. We all need to redouble our effort to promote the use of masks and vaccinations. There is a walk-in vaccination clinic in Warren Community Center, 7 Sockett Rd, on September 29<sup>th</sup> from 11am to 7pm. Information about the additional shot recommended for immunocompromised individuals is available on the CDC website. Individuals should reach out to their healthcare provider for further guidance.

This week we had a visitor to the Town Hall test positive for COVID. We are closing the Town Hall to visitors as of next Thursday September 16<sup>th</sup> to help protect our office workers.
