RESOLVED, that the Board of Finance (1) acknowledges the advice of the Board of Selectmen regarding procedures for disbursing the Town's ARPA funds, (2) supports the decision to delegate disbursement authority to the Committee, and (3) supports the Committee and acknowledges its authority to determine suitable award recipients.
