Temporary Road Closures

Life is rarely boring in Cornwall - except for Thursday 8/31 in West Cornwall when River Road will be closed to through traffic for soil boring at the bridge near Route 128 from 8:30am to about 4:00pm. The purpose of the boring session is to get necessary information for the Town hired Engineer to design a better retaining all on Mill Brook. The River Road bridge itself is fine but the rock retaining wall underneath the Whiteford's beautiful flowers was damaged in the heavy rains of early July. The town is looking to install a more flood resistant wall this fall.

There will also be resurfacing of Dudleytown and Everest Hill Roads on Tuesday 8/29 (tomorrow) and Wednesday 8/30. Popple Swamp and West Road will be paved on Thursday 8/31. Any traffic delays should be brief. We apologize for any inconvenience of this necessary work. There will be a lot of trucks in these areas during this week.
