# 1 - Bid Review	First Selectman Ridgway gave an overview of the bid process and a summary of the findings for the replacement / repair of the retaining wall on River Road @ Mill Brook.		
	Discussion was contemporaneous with the overview and summary and covered the following topics.		
	a) Damage resulted from the July 2023 storm event, no FEMA funding available.		
	b) Engineering firm WMC did an initial assessment and created Bid Packages.		
	A pre construction meeting was held, and bid packages were opened on 10.23.23. All the bids c) came in higher than anticipated.		
	 After the bid opening, one contractor suggested a different solution to the repair by using d) precast concrete. This solution was considered and the path forward would be to reject all the bids and issue a new bid package using the precast concrete to facilitate the repair. e) WMC is working on new bid package. 		
	f) The precast concrete option is convenient, safe and can reduced construction time.		
	g) A Town meeting to be held on 11.3.23 to appropriate funding to complete this repair.		
	h) DEEP and DOT considerations and influence or input on this repair.
