- 1) To receive reports of the officers, boards and commissions having reports to make.
- 2) To adopt the Five Year Capital Plan for the Town of Cornwall as recommended by the Board of Finance and the Board of Selectmen.
- 3) Upon recommendation of the Board of Selectman, to adopt an ordinance for the establishment of an Affordable Housing Commission. Text available at the Town Clerk Office.
- 4) To amend the ordinance, last amended October 23, 2009, Building Permit Fees, to increase the fees as follows:

Building Permits – Each additional \$1,000	\$7.00	\$10.00
Tent Fee	None	\$50.00




