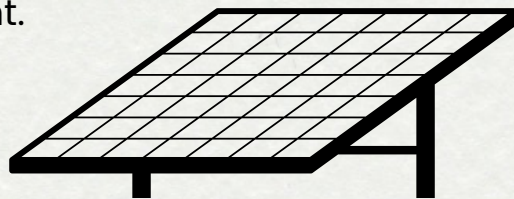
Hello Friends,

Some exciting news from Town Hall this week. Storm damage repairs have been completed near the Popple Swamp bridge and on Essex Hill Road, which is now open for traffic. We thank the contractors for their good work.



Also, the Town received word this week of a grant award of \$868,000 to install sidewalks, crosswalks, and other pedestrian/bicycle/parking in Cornwall Bridge and West Cornwall. The successful grant application is available for **[viewing here](#)**.
