The Planning and Zoning Commission continues to work on the Town Plan Goal of increasing more diverse housing opportunities in Cornwall. We will hold a Public Hearing on June 11 at 7:00 pm on our plan to allow duplexes and triplexes in Cornwall, as well as inviting any developer may apply to build affordable Multi-family Housing in Cornwall. (Previously only the Town or Not-For-Profits were allowed to apply for such permits).
