

You Are Invited! Informational Woods Tour Upcoming Harvests on State Land

Please join foresters from the CT DEEP Division of Forestry for a guided walk through 2 areas scheduled for upcoming forest product harvests in Housatonic State Forest. The harvests will salvage dead and dying oak trees impacted by spongy moth (*Lymantria dispar dispar*) and encourage forest regeneration. We will discuss the specifics of the harvests and answer questions from attendees.
