November Election / Who – When – and Where’s

Who can vote in the November Election?

US Citizens who are registered can participate in voting. *Note: Former Cornwall residents who are US Citizens should contact the Town Clerk’s office to determine eligibility*

Important Registration Dates:

October 18, 2024: Last day to register in person and mail-in. The Registrar of Voters will be open from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. for in person registration. All mail-in voter registration applications must be received or post-marked by this date in order to be accepted. The Online Voter Registration System will also close on this date.

Voter Registration for Early Voting: Same Day Registration (SDR) is available at the Early Voting location during the early voting period (October 21st-November 3rd)

November 4, 2024: Deadline for admitting those seeking to vote in the Election whose qualification as to age, citizenship, or residence was attained on or after October 19th. Registrar of Voter’s office will be open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

When can I vote?

- *ABSENTEE VOTING: October 4, 2024-November 4, 2024
- **EARLY VOTING: Monday, Oct. 21, 2024 through Monday, Oct. 28, 2024
