




I hope you have been okay beating this latest heat wave. Thanks to the Library and other air-conditioned spaces, our merchants for keeping us supplied with cold beverages, our first responders who have had to go on calls at all hours, neighbors checking on neighbors, and lifeguards keeping summers safe. The Town did receive an advisory yesterday that a test from June 10th did indicate elevated E. Coli counts at the Town Beach. The TAHD advises swimmers to: Not submerge your head or drink lake water, and to shower after swimming. More testing has been done and we will keep you updated on results and recommendations.
