### **PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION | ANNA TIMELL, CHAIR**

The P&Z Commission will hold a public hearing on August 12 at 7:00 pm, in person, at the library, on a proposed amendment to our zoning regulations. The amendment will discontinue the requirement that a buildable area on a lot must take a rectangular shape.

The intent is to remove an unnecessary barrier to the creation of a building lot.

### **CORNWALL AGRICULTURAL COMMISSION | BILL DINNEEN, CHAIR**

The Ag. Fair will be coming up on September 13th. 10-4 with judged items in Town Hall, games on the Green, hay bales and animals as well. This year we will be grilling hot dogs and hamburgers using local beef and franks from our local farmers. The Ag.
